WELCOME TO UNIVERSITY OF SHANGHALFOR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

The University of Shanghai for Science
and Technology (USST) is located in the
North-East of Shanghai between Huangpu River and
Central Link. The main part of the University is in Yangpu
District and can be traced back to the University of Shanghai which
was founded in 1906 and, in 2016, celebrated its 110th anniversary. The
part located at Xuhui District (SBC Campus) was founded in 1907 by Deutsche
Medizinschule. In May 1996, East China University of Technology (former Shanghai Institute of Mchanical
Engineering) and the Shanghai Institute of Mechanical Technology, merged to form the University of
Shanghai for Science and Technology. In 1999, Shanghai Institute of Optical Instruments joinedUSST.
In July 2003, Shanghai Medical Instrumentation College and Shanghai Publishing and Printing Colege

were also incorporated into USST.

USST has accepted the challenge of developing undergraduate and graduate programmes and is adopting international standards. It has established formal collaborations with more than 80 universities in America, Britain, Germany, Canada, Japan, Australia and other countries throughout the world. Two international joint venture institutions – the Sino-British College and Sino-German College (sometimes referred to as the Shanghai-Hamburg college) - include Chinese and international students.
